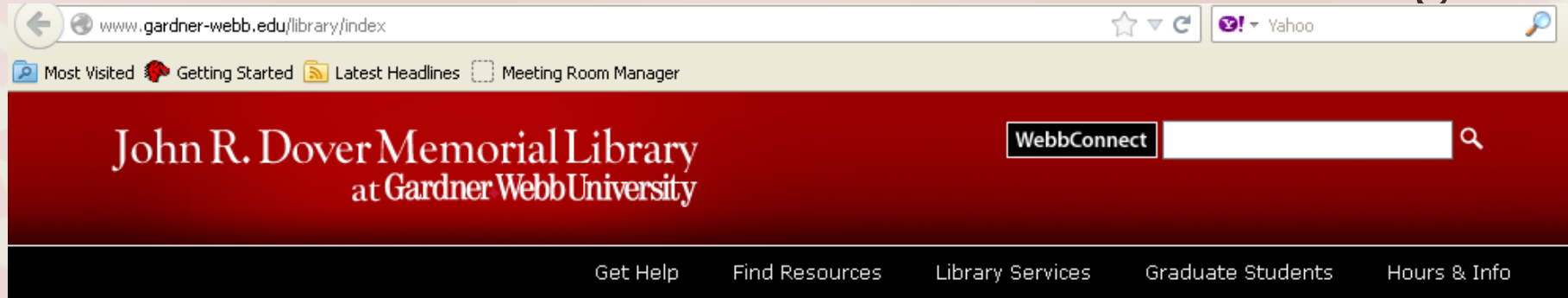

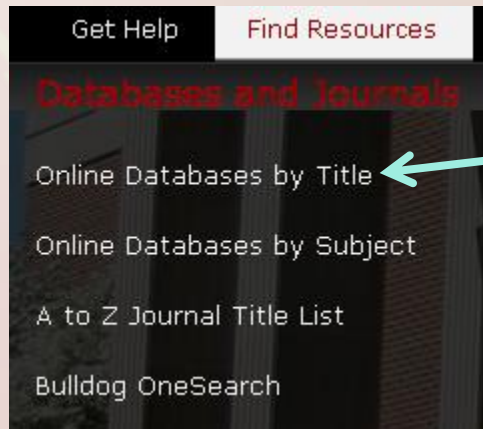

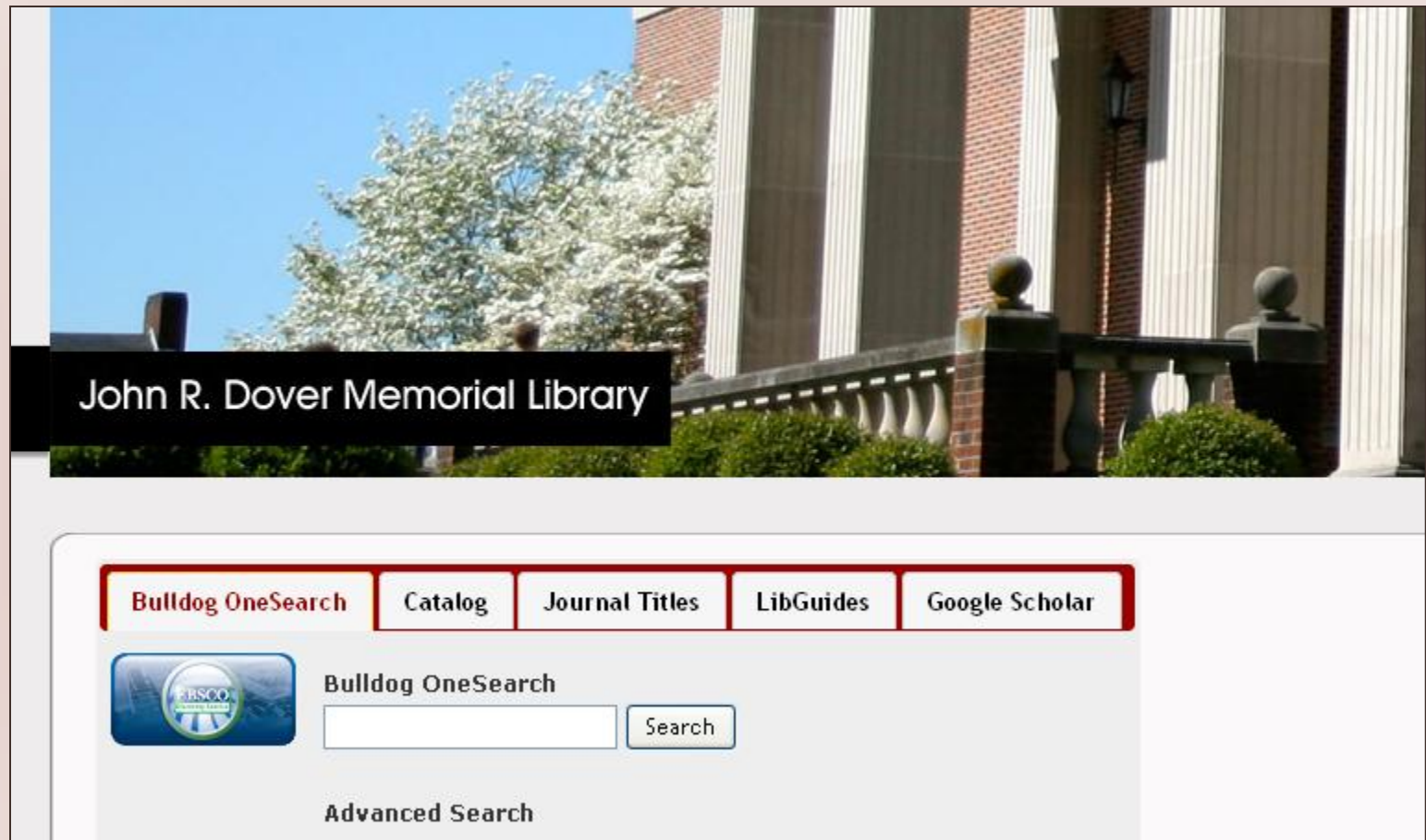

Advanced Search

Advanced “Bulldog OneSearch” searches the catalog and about 80% of the databases’ content.

A “Catalog” search shows books, DVDs, eBooks, music CDs, and other material. You can search in many different ways. Try a keyword search if you do not know a title or author.

Interlibrary Loan

- InterLibrary loan is a service that allows you to request research items that are not owned by Dover Library.
- To Make a request:
 - ◇ Sign up with ILLiad, our interlibrary loan system, using your MyWebb user name and password.
 - Library Homepage>Library Services>ILLiad Logon
 - ◇ Fill out the request form in ILLiad for the type of resource you need.
- Request can take between 7 - 14 days to arrive

Interlibrary Loan

Requesting Books

- Return all ILL books to the Dover Library
- Due Dates on ILL books are set by the lending library and will vary.
- Overdue fines are accrued at \$1 per day, per book.

Requesting Articles

- Articles are yours to keep.
- Articles that are provided via a web link should be accessed and saved or printed immediately. These links often time out in 30 days or less.
- Check to see if the article is available at the Dover Library by using the A to Z Journal Title List before you request it. Instructions:

Requesting Books/Articles housed at Dover Library

- If you do not attend classes at Gardner-Webb's Boiling Springs campus or live in Cleveland County, you can request to have resources from Dover Library mailed to your home or work address.
- To request these items, fill out the same request form in ILLiad that you would use for an ILL request.
- Items NOT available for request include:
 - Reference Books
 - Special Collections
 - Archive Materials
- Requested items will be sent to you within 3 – 5 business days.
